Students united to claim their rights

When the formation of ENI students was completed on Thursday, August 11, students should have returned to their families the following day.

But the students are still on the campus. With reason: they did not receive their last scholarships.

Students enrolled at the ENI through an entrance examination are entitled to a grant from the State of 33,000 FCFA per month to help finance their education. The accounting officer of ENI deducts housing and canteen costs on the ENI campus and pays them 9,000 FCFA every month.

The librarian informed the students on Thursday that their scholarships for July and August will not be paid. In addition, payments their month of internship has been insufficient: in fact, since they don't benefit from the canteen of ENI during such periods, students should receive 10,000 FCFA but only 9,000 FCFA were paid to them. They should also have received compensation for the meals they had to take care of themselves during the period of the RIDEF.

The administration has left the premises, leaving the students in disarray. They are very angry. Discontent demonstrations began on Thursday.

Students took control of the entrance gate of ENI: only the authorities can enter, no one gets out.

They wanted to march through the streets of Dogbo to the town hall, but the city authorities came to appease the situation. The director of ENI will receive all students together.

Students remain mobilized. They hope the situation will be quickly resolved so that everyone can go home.

Clashes between students and administration have already occurred in early July in ENI-Allada.
