

## WORK PLANS 2016 - 2018

1. Categorization of countries A, B, C
2. Revision of the Charter and the Rules of Procedure
3. Criteria for candidature to the Central Committee
4. A call to all of the Frienet movements to involve themselves in the defence of knowledge as a common good
5. Continue developing organizational tools for the Central Committee and the FIMEM... Calendar, RRT, the decision-making process,...
6. Strengthen relationships with the various movements and demand that each and everyone of them remit activity reports to the Central Committee or to publish them on our website so that they might be shared
7. Develop an instrument of communication between the various movements, in the form of a "multiletter", to be published 3 times a year
8. Work towards attracting new generations of teachers to the movement
9. Reflect upon ways to improve FIMEM's relationship with the international organizations
10. Promote democratization of education and life long learning for everybody, first and foremost for the most disadvantaged
11. Encourage our colleagues to include the respect for the rights of children in the regulations of their schools - in accordance with the political agreements already made by their authorities
12. Improve the communication between the movements (e.g with a " multiletter" 3 times a year)
13. Update the categories A, B, C and the membership fee amount
14. Look for voluntary translators – for a period of 2 years – in the 3 official languages
15. Classify the documents on the site of the FIMEM
16. Cooperate with the ICEM and "Les Amis de Freinet" to encourage them to spread the rich documentation to be found in our archives
