

HERE ARE SOME SUGGESTIONS ON HOW TO GET TO LJUNGSKILE from Europe

Buy an INTERRAIL CARD! It is a cheap way for participants from Europe to go to RIDEF . Then you are free to travel around before or after RIDEF as well. (For Non-Europeans there is the EURAIL PASS) .

The German Railway Company has the best website for finding the timetables of all European trains! www.bahn.com/view (in English)

The Danish Railway Company DSB is even giving you a 15% reduction on ordinary prices if you buy your card before the 26th of Dec 2017 which you then can use in the summer of 2018 (www.dsb.dk/interrail or their International Service Center:+45-70 13 14 18)

Choose between 5 travelling days within a period of 15 days or 7, 10 or 15 travelling days within a period of 30 days. Reservations are extra. Up to two children under 12 years old travel for free with an adult. They have to have their own pass though (for free)

Look at for ex www.Scyscanner to compare prices, they give you prices for the whole month - with other dates you can come down to 117€!

If you come by plane and want to go to Gothenburg (for further transportation to Ljungskile (65km): 1h by bus or train, approx 14€)

Reductions for students and 65+. Children mostly free up to 15 years + seat reservation fee

From Stockholm to Gothenburg	470km	3 ½h trip by train	One way: 20€ - 65€ depending on when and how far in advance you buy your ticket
From Copenhagen, Kastrup Airport	300km	3 ½h trip by train	One way: approx 50€
From Copenhagen, Kastrup Airport	300km	4h trip by bus	One way: approx 25€ f ex Swebus
From Oslo, Gardemoen Airport	300km	4 ½ trip by bus	One way: 25-440€ f ex Swebus
